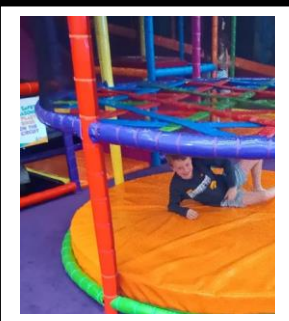

Warmer Weather Ahead!

We are in the weird part of spring in Iowa where anything can happen with the weather. With the instability of the weather please be mindful of what your children are wearing to school. Keep an eye on the forecast and dress them appropriately. It is important to get outside as much as possible and we go outside in temperatures as low as 35 degrees. Layers are always a good idea this time of year.

Sunscreen and Bug Spray

At CCYC we apply sunscreen from April to October. Your classroom teachers will be reaching out to you about sunscreen and bug spray to leave in the classroom for the summer if they haven't already reached out. Sunscreen is required and can be either spray or cream but must be SPF 50 or higher and not expired. Bug spray is optional, but highly recommended to have for your child. Once the teachers have the sunscreen and bug spray, they will fill out a medication authorization form for you to sign.
