## From the CCYC Office

### ● Child and Adult Care Food Program

The Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) is a federally funded, USDA program that provides centers who provide healthy snacks and meals to children in childcare centers reimbursement for meals served. Ms. Nicole sent out the CACFP enrollment packet in July to all CCYC families. If you have not received your family's packet, please reach out to your child's teacher. Those enrollment packets are due back to us August 4, 2023. There is an income eligibility form in that enrollment packet. This is to see where your family lies within the tiered

reimbursement scale. If you think your family might qualify for the free or reduced rate, please fill the form out completely.

We have also returned to family-style meals and the children are so excited and proud of themselves for serving their own food. We will start tracking the meal totals for reimbursement.

Enrollment in the CACFP is one of the first steps to being part of the Iowa Quality for Kids (IQ4K) program. We want to show the community what a quality center we have. If you have any questions or concerns about these programs, please speak to Ms. Amanda or Ms. Nicole.

### August Move-up for Preschool Program

Our next scheduled move up in the preschool program will be coming up soon. We will have three days of transition time that increases each day they go to their next classroom from August 23<sup>rd</sup> through August 25<sup>th</sup>.
