Warmer Weather Ahead!

We are in the weird part of spring in Iowa where anything can happen with the weather. With the instability of the weather please be mindful of what your children are wearing to school. Keep an eye on the forecast and dress them appropriately. It is important to get outside as much as possible and we go outside in temperatures as low as 35 degrees. Layers are always a good idea this time of year. Remember that once we transition to sandal weather that all sandals wore should have a back on them.

Sunscreen and Bug Sprav

Our teachers have been collecting sunscreen and bug spray for the summer months. We apply and reapply sunscreen when we are outside. Our sunscreen should be SPF 50 or higher. This number is an HHS requirement, not our policy. Our playground is very shaded with our trees and our sunshade. Unless otherwise set up with parents, we will not apply sunscreen for our gross motor play outside.
