Hot Weather Safety Tips

With the recent heat advisories, it is time to talk about staying safe in the summer heat. Every year over 600 American's die from heat related issues. Older adults, those with chronic health conditions, and young children are at a higher risk. Here are some helpful hints.

1. Stay away from direct sun exposure: Stay inside and try to plan any outdoor activities early in the morning or in the evening.
2. Stay Hydrated: Drink plenty of water and electrolyte liquids that do not contain caffeine.
3. Air Conditioning: Spend as much time as possible in air-conditioned spaces.
4. Dress Appropriately: Wear loose, light colored clothes.
5. Cool down: Take tepid (cool) showers or baths when you are feeling overheated.
6. Know the signs: Children under 4 years old don't know enough to slow down on hot days. Children's sweat glands are not fully developed, so they are at a higher risk than adults for dehydration and heat stroke.

July Field Trips

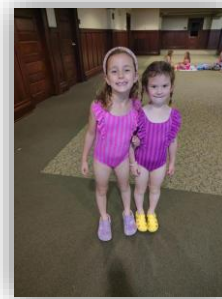
